ADMISSION

Admission of NEW learners opens on the 1st of July and closes on the 30th of November each year. Late admissions attract a late registration fee of R1500 for Grades 1 to 10 and R5000 for Grade 11.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

1. School reports from the current school. 2. Certified copy of Identity Document of GUARDIAN/PARENT. 3. Certified copy of birth certificate of learner. 4. Transfer letter from current school. 5. Registration fee (non-refundable.) 6. Proof of residential address. 7. Latest payslip and 3 months bank statement. Additional requirements for international students: valid passport/asylum papers.
